

## Arc'teryx Sentry jacket

There's more to winter sports than skiing, snowboarding and hot-tubbing. While the Sentry is great on the slopes, it's also got you covered on the sled and on the frozen lake. Stop-and-go winter backcountry enthusiasts will also find the pit zips a welcome way to cool down if the nonquilted Primaloft insulation gives them the sweats. Nonquilted means the insulation isn't held in place with stitchwork so it lofts more, creating more space to trap warmth. The wind, rain and snow won't get through the Gore-Tex Pro Shell outer material. The fit is more relaxed than athletic, but the adjustable snowskirt keeps out drafts and white stuff. When it gets nasty, unzip the hideaway, helmet-compatible hood.
